Professor	MD/MS/DNB/ PhD in the concerned subject.	(a) (i) Associate Professor in the subject for three years in a recognised medical institution; or (ii) Specialist Medical Officer of the Armed Forces having at least three years of experience as Associate Professor in the relevant speciality in a teaching hospital of the Armed Forces; and (b) (i) have published at least two research publications after becoming Associate Professor and must be amongst the first three authors; (ii) have completed the Basic Course in Biomedical Research from a recognised medical institution; and (iii) shall be required to undergo Basic Course in Medical Education provided their broad specialty subject is covered under undergraduate training. Note 1: In the case of Aviation Medicine and Marine Medicine, two years of experience as Flying Squadron for Aviation and two years of experience in a Diving and Escape Training School for Marine medicine, shall be considered equivalent to one-year teaching experience as Associate Professor. Note 2: A Senior Consultant, having three years of experience as post graduate teacher of broad specialty or super specialty subject in the National Board of Examination in Medical Sciences recognised Government medical institute shall be eligible to become Professor in a recognised medical institution of the concerned specialty and total number of years of experience as Post Graduate teacher in National Board of Examination in Medical Sciences recognised government medical institute shall be considered as experience as Professor in a recognised medical institution.
Associate Professor	MD/MS/DNB/ PhD in the concerned subject.	(a) (i) Assistant Professor in the subject for four years in a recognised medical institution or for five years for those appointed directly as Assistant Professor in Government medical institution; or (ii) a Specialist Medical Officer of the Armed Forces, having at least five years of clinical experience in the relevant specialty after obtaining the recognised Postgraduate qualification in the subject, of which at least three years teaching experience as Assistant Professor in a teaching hospital of the Armed Forces; and (b) (i) have published at least two research publications after becoming Assistant Professor and must be amongst first three authors; (ii) have completed the Basic Course in Biomedical Research from a recognised medical institution designated by the Commission; and (iii) shall be required to undergo Basic Course in Medical Education provided their broad specialty subject is covered under undergraduate training. Note 1: In the specialty of Aviation Medicine and Marine Medicine, maximum of four years' experience in Flying Squadrons and in Diving and Escape training Schools, respectively, will be considered equivalent to two years of teaching experience for becoming Associate Professor. Note 2: A non-teaching Consultant or Specialist or Medical Officer, possessing postgraduate medical degree with 10 years of experience in at least 220 bedded Government

		hospital shall be eligible to become Associate Professor of that broad specialty and on such appointment, shall be required to undergo Basic Course in Medical Education and Basic Course in Biomedical Research within two years of the appointment.
Assistant Professor	MD/MS/DNB/ PhD in the concerned subject.	(a) one year as Senior Resident in the concerned subject as specified in regulation 8 in a recognised medical institution. Note 1: The requirement of one-year Senior Resident experience is relaxed for those appointed directly as Assistant Professor in Government medical institute immediately before the publication of these regulations. Note 2: The experience gained by a Tutor in a medical institution of his specialty, having a postgraduate degree, shall be considered equivalent to the experience required as a Senior Resident for the purpose of eligibility for the post of Assistant Professor. Note 3: The experience gained by a Demonstrator in a medical institution of his specialty, having a Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy degree, shall be considered equivalent to the experience required as a Senior Resident for the purpose of eligibility for the post of Assistant Professor; or (b) Specialist Medical Officers of the Armed Forces having at least one year teaching experience or two years of clinical experience after obtaining the requisite postgraduate qualification in the concerned subject. Note: In the specialty of Aviation Medicine and Marine Medicine two years of such experience in flying Squadrons and in Diving and Escape training Schools respectively will be considered equivalent to one year of teaching experience (in lieu of Senior Resident) to become an Assistant Professor; or (c) a non-teaching Consultant or Specialist or Medical Officer, possessing postgraduate medical degree with at least two years of experience in a Government hospital having at least 220 beds shall be eligible to become an Assistant Professor of that broad specialty without the requirement of experience as Senior Resident and shall complete the Basic Course in Biomedical Research within two years of appointment; or (d) Diploma holders appointed as Senior Residents in a recognised medical institution before 08.06.2017 having total experience of four years as Senior Resident; or (e) Diploma holders working as Specialist or Medical Officer in the respective departments of a government medical institution or Government medical institution running National Board of Examination and Medical Science recognised teaching programme having cumulative experience of six years.

Note: For the purposes of appointment as faculty in Emergency Medicine department, the previous teaching experience in the broad specialties of General Surgery or Anaesthesia or Respiratory Medicine or Orthopaedics or General Medicine shall be counted and, on such appointment, shall complete faculty development programme or trainings prescribed by the Commission, within two years of appointment.

Note: – Candidate who have fulfilled all the criteria as per National Medical Commission Notification on Dated 30th June 2025. **F. No.N-P051(12)/18/2024-PGMEB-NMC** are Eligible to Apply.
